The insulation will cost in the region of £500 plus the installation of the access hatch. The Clerk has asked Tony Burden to make the loft access. The Clerk will ask Andover Glass to quote for the trickle vents.

COMMUNAL GARDEN – Matt Townsend has done a sterling job on the garden. Tony Burden is due to start work on removing the old outbuildings and concrete bases later in the month. Matt Townsend will then lay the turf.

CAR BARNS – The Clerk has a list of companies that supply car barns. Once the site has been cleared and correct measurements taken he will proceed with getting quotes.
